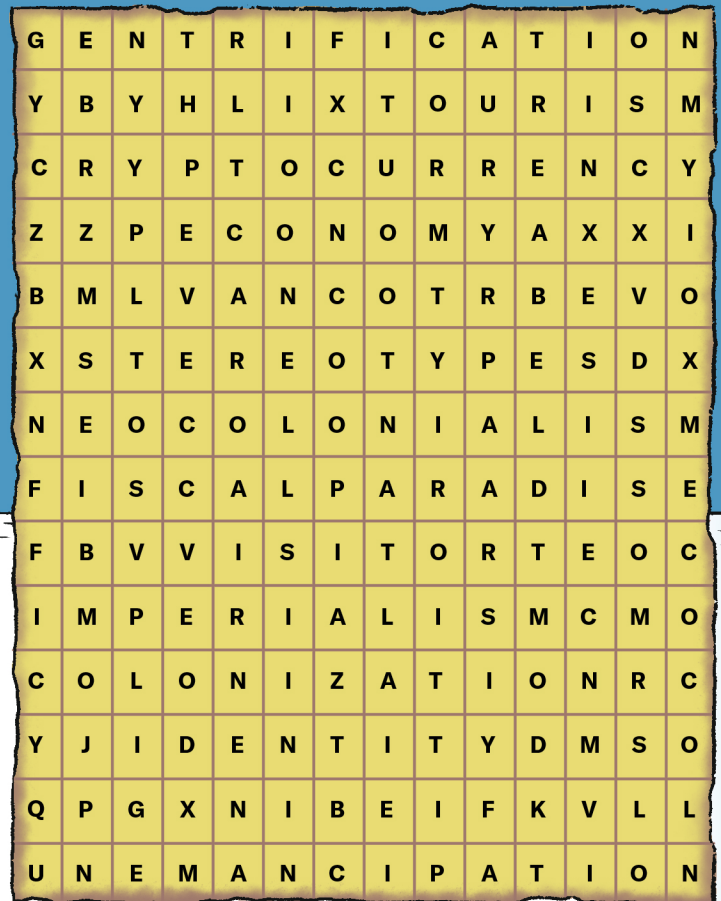

2 “_____ refers to the economic activity (goods consumed and services rendered) of the people who visit a place, and how this can be projected onto the way a society is built around servicing its visitors.”²

3 “_____ are mental images that people build about others, which come from certain characteristics and are schematic and simplified representations of a group of people. These can be true or false but are made up of an extreme simplification of a complex reality.”³

4 “Refers to the residual control that different geopolitical powers have over less developed states. While colonialism was a form of territorial and political occupation that gave way to economic dominance, _____ is characterized by its indirect control through exploitation and commodification of natural resources and cultural influence.”⁴

5 “_____ is a social, cultural and economic phenomenon that requires the movement of people to countries or places outside of their normal environment due to personal, professional or business reasons.”⁵

6 “_____ happens when an urban renovation or construction process comes with an influx of middle class or wealthier people, which usually displaces the poorer residents of those areas.”⁶

7 “_____ is a process that allows an individual or a group of people to obtain a certain level of autonomy that up to that point was non-existent due to some sort of ownership or submission.”⁷

8 “_____ is the doctrine that defends the dominance of a nation or state over other territories or towns through the acquisition of lands or the imposition of political and economic control.”⁸

9 “_____ is the act of extending the economic, political or cultural dominance of a society or a state over others, generally through military intervention.”⁹

10 “_____ is comprised of a digital archive with a unique code that is read through different programs that work to visualize it, preserve it and perform transactions.”¹⁰

11 “_____ is a set of characteristics that differentiate an individual or a group from the rest. It is from this, that people can distinguish themselves from others. It always depends on world view, history of the self or the context one is living in.”¹¹
